



Garagefest 2026 Pinup Girl Comp Terms & Conditions

1. By applying to enter this Pinup Girl competition at Garagefest the Applicant agrees to comply with and be bound by the terms and conditions.
2. Applicants must be available to participate in the Competition on the Saturday 9am-4pm and we would love them to attend Sunday 9am-4pm too.
3. Age Requirement: Contestants must be 18 years or older.
4. Dress Code: Participants are expected to wear classic glamour, rockabilly, retro, vintage, modern pin up or rock'n'roll that promotes, the 40s, 50s, 60s, 70s, including hair, makeup, and shoes. Bikinis, swimsuits or nudity are not allowed. Attire needs to be considerate, respectful, and avoid exploitative, political or culturally insensitive attire.
5. Behaviour Expectations: Bullying, disrespectful behaviour, or drama will not be tolerated. We are not playing for sheep stations let's keep it fun and all inclusive!
6. Judging Criteria: Judges will evaluate contestants based on their appearance, their crowd, vendor and vehicle entrant interactions throughout the day, creativity, adherence to the dress code and their write up in in the application. Winner and runner up will be chosen at the discretion of the Selection Panel appointed by Garagefest and all decisions are final.
7. Event Details: Participants receive free entry into Garagefest event.
8. Fees and Prizes: Entry into the Pinup Girl Comp is \$25 per person. First Prize is a hamper pack to the value of \$500 and runner up receives a hamper pack to the value of \$150. These include hair products, but not limited to, donated by NAK and a local hairdresser.
9. Applicants must always promote the interests of the Garagefest, and must not slander the Garagefest in any way, including via social media platforms
10. Applicants will not smoke or vape during garagefest and will abide by public smoking laws within the Showgrounds.
11. Applicants will not become intoxicated during Garagefest or arrive to Garagefest intoxicated and are prohibited from bringing alcohol to Garagefest.
12. Applicants must not consume any illicit drugs or substances during the Event or arrive to the Event under the influence of any illicit drugs or substances.

13. Applicants must report all accidents and incidents to Garagefest Event Coordinator as soon as practicably able. In the event of an emergency, Applicants must follow directions of the Event Organiser, Emergency Services including Queensland Police Service, Queensland Ambulance Service, Queensland Fire and Emergency Services and/or Event Security Personnel and Marshalls and Fraser Coast Council Rules and Regulations
14. Applicants must at all times comply with the Work Health and Safety Act 2011 which governs the standards of health and safety in the workplace in Queensland.
15. Applicants waive all rights to have any claim for payment or royalties regarding any exhibition, televising, or other publication of the pinup girl competition. The Applicant also waives any right to inspect or approve any photo, video, or film taken by the Event Organisers. The Applicant releases and discharge the Event Organisers and its affiliates from any liability for any blurring, distortion, alteration, optical illusion, or use in composite form, intentional or otherwise, that may occur or be produced in the taking of pictures or in any processing toward the completion of the finished product. All negatives and positives, whether prints, video, film, or sound recording are the property of the event coordinators, solely and completely.
